	The Minutes were agreed as an accurate reflection of the last meeting. Clarification was made to item 5.2, in that the Government are undertaking a study of the UK Port sector as a whole, not the Port of Poole in particular.

3.1	Update on 5G	
	Ruth Spencer and Adrian Hale from Bournemouth Borough Council gave an update on 5G. They explained that Central Government want to be a world leader in 5G, as it will generate significant inward investment opportunities and they want to allocate £1.1 bn to it nationally. Ruth and Adrian are looking at having more conversations to understand the potential with the private sector. They have been asked to attend a pre-meeting prior to a meeting with DCMS.	
	Action: Ruth Spencer/Adrian Hale to let the LEP know the date of the meeting with DCMS and asked whether someone representing the LEP could attend this meeting with them.	RS/AH
