They can foresee a need to expand the Growth Hub but will wait for a 3-6 month period for the programme to bed in and will look at funding next year and whether they need to take on more people.	
	Lucy confirmed that WSX, a not for profit organisation, is the company that runs the contract and the Growth Hub is a brand. The managing authority is DCLG.	
	AM praised the support the Growth Hub has provided in the rural areas.
