Supporting Southeast Dorset's communities to live well since 1850.


Set up by sisters Georgina and Mary Anne Talbot in the 1850s

URBAN GROWING HUB

- Small Business Finance Markets report 2022/23 & Intermediary Survey 2022/23
- -51% SW businesses anticipating growth in next 12 months
- -7/10 intermediaries believe SMEs lack understanding and awareness of finance options available to them
- Half of intermediaries believe business viability hinders their ability







Next generation of regional funds

- £660m A new Northern Powerhouse Investment Fund to include the North-East
- **£400m A new Midlands Engine Investment Fund**
- £200m A new fund for the South West of England
- £70m A new fund to expand provision for businesses in Northern Ireland
- £150m A new fund for Scottish businesses
- £130m A new fund for Welsh businesses
