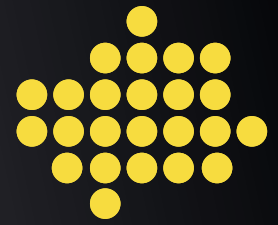

## VISUAL EFFECTS (VFX)

### VFX in Dorset

Dorset is a growing centre of excellence for visual effects and a major contributor to the UK's world-renowned VFX capability. Bournemouth and Poole are the UK's top areas for high growth digital businesses<sup>1</sup>. Several film studios are based here as is the National Centre for Computer Animation (NCCA). Bournemouth University and Arts University Bournemouth offer world-class VFX and animation technology degree courses producing a high-skilled workforce; several film directors as well as Oscar and BAFTA nominees for VFX are local university graduates. It has an extensive cultural, film and arts programme and a strong business support service for inward investors.

Dorset is also at the forefront of 5G wireless communications technology plans and is spearheading the development of a Smart Place ecosystem – a major pull for technology-based companies, particularly app developers. It is leading the development of new technologies, exploring ways artificial intelligence, for example, can be used creatively in gaming. Local companies such as Cudo Ventures are heavily involved with block chain, mostly for the benefit of the charitable sector.



### The opportunity

With the total annual value of VFX to the UK economy estimated at over £1 billion, and the global VFX market predicted to grow 12.78%<sup>2</sup> p.a, the creative industry is booming. In the South West, the creative industries generate £8.7 billion per year and employ 347,000 people – 7.9% of the UK's creative industry jobs<sup>3</sup>. Dorset's two main towns, Bournemouth and Poole have been identified as the country's top areas for high growth digital businesses.

With a generous film tax relief system, supportive government and world-class VFX talent pool the region is well-placed to take advantage of the ongoing growth in VFX driven film and television projects.

Bournemouth University and Arts University Bournemouth produce around 800 world-class multi-discipline media graduates every year, enabling employers to draw on an enviable VFX, animation and post-production talent pool.



## Support for Dorset's VFX economy

### Bournemouth University (BU):

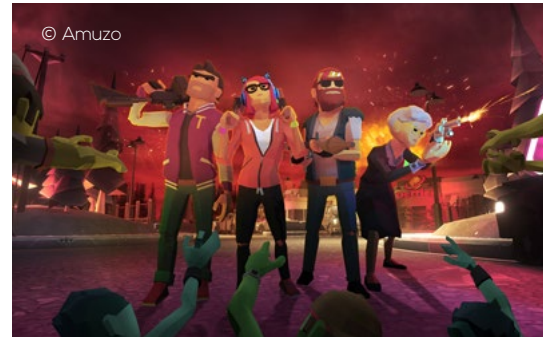
- The Faculty of Media and Communication at BU is home to the National Centre for Computer Animation (NCCA). Established in 1989, its alumni form the backbone of the UK's VFX industry. NCCA graduates have won Oscars and BAFTAs for their work on movies including Interstellar, Inception and Ex-Machina
- The NCCA's Research Group along with researchers from BU's Faculty of Science and Technology work collaboratively with local, national and international partners across a diverse range of projects, including medical and healthcare, cyber security, facial recognition and engineering. Developing technologies which blur the boundaries between art, science and media has been prioritised by the group and is at the core of many current collaborations including:
  - › Artificial Intelligence based augmented, virtual and mixed reality
  - › Location-based experiential gaming using the Unreal Engine and 5G connectivity
- BU also delivers undergraduate and postgraduate degree courses in VFX games, TV production, scriptwriting, cinematography, digital media and journalism

### VFX Hub:

- Based in the NCCA at BU, the VFX Hub was created to raise the profile of the region as a centre of excellence for VFX and computer animation. It provides commercial outlets and links to industry for students, graduates and academic staff as well as running the BFX Festival each year

### Arts University Bournemouth (AUB)

- AUB is globally recognised for its outstanding programme of art, animation, VFX and filmmaking courses. Internationally successful directors such as Edgar Wright are amongst its alumni
- AUB also delivers a range of undergraduate and postgraduate degree courses including photography, illustration, model making, make-up and costume and set design

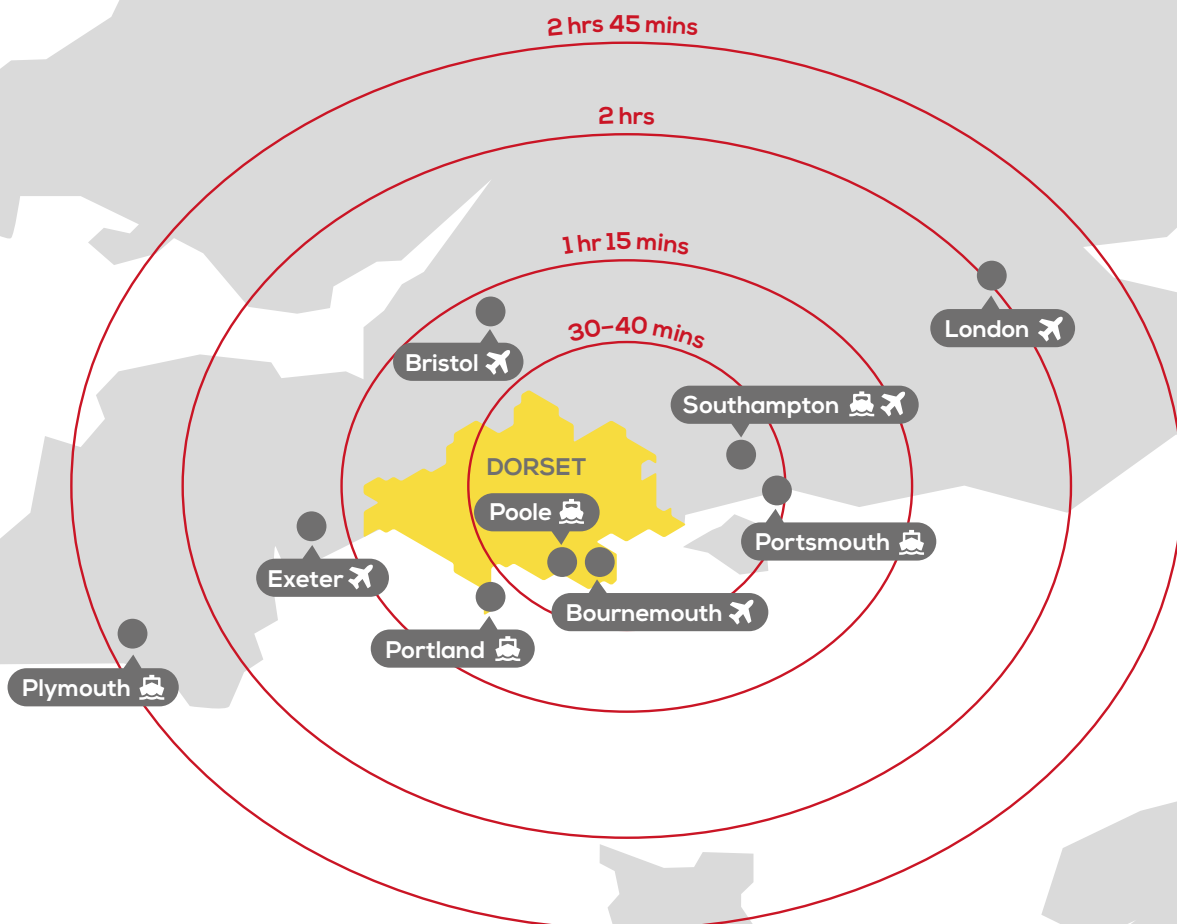
## Connectivity
