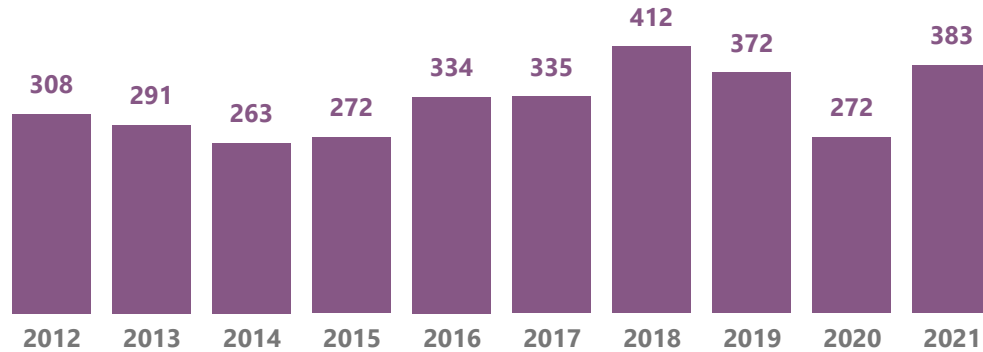

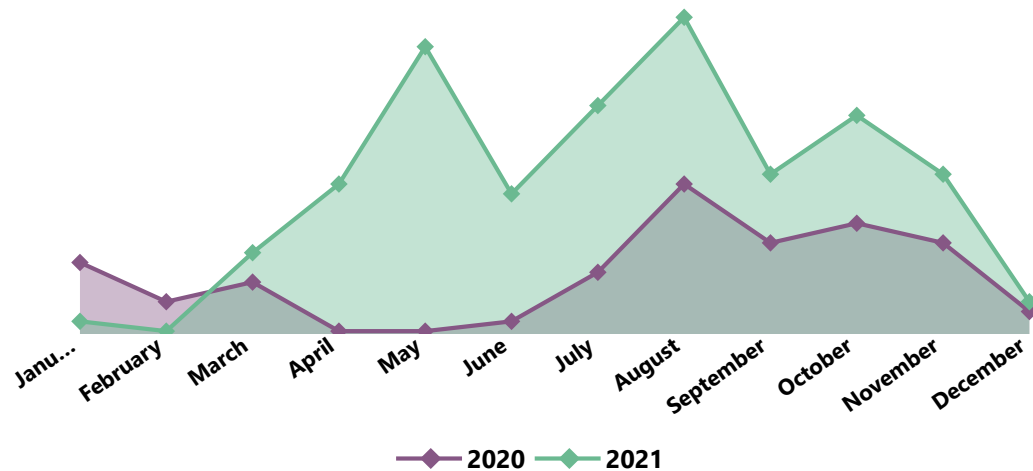

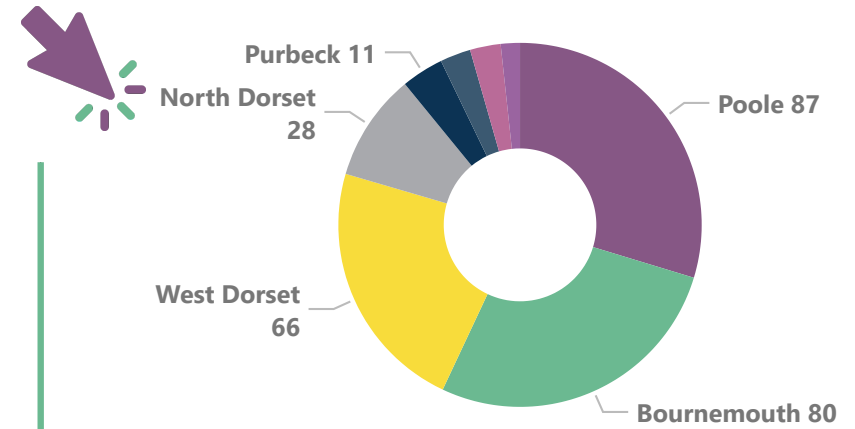

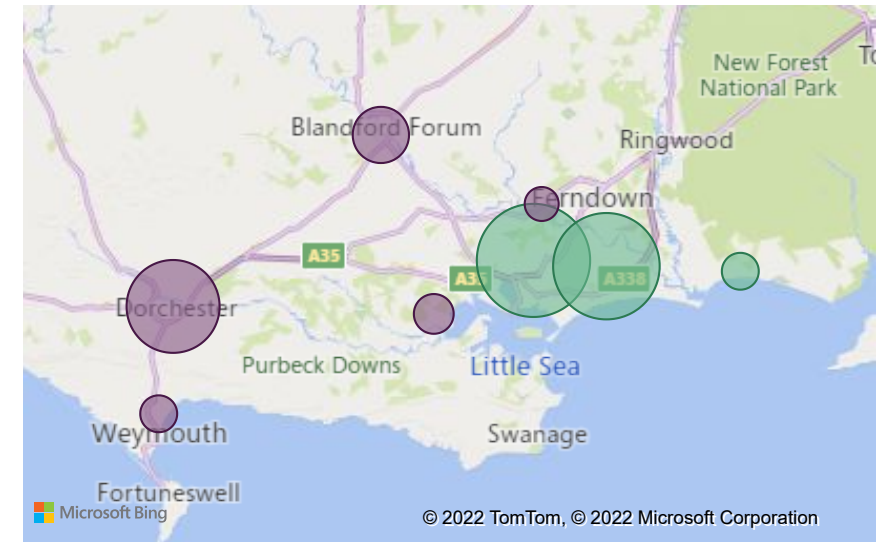
Jobs posted in Dorset (2020-2021)-monthly

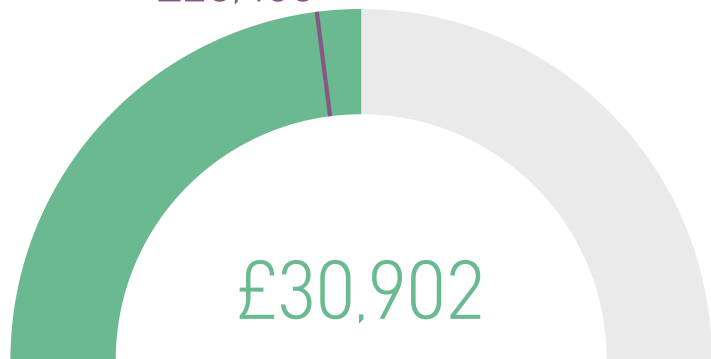

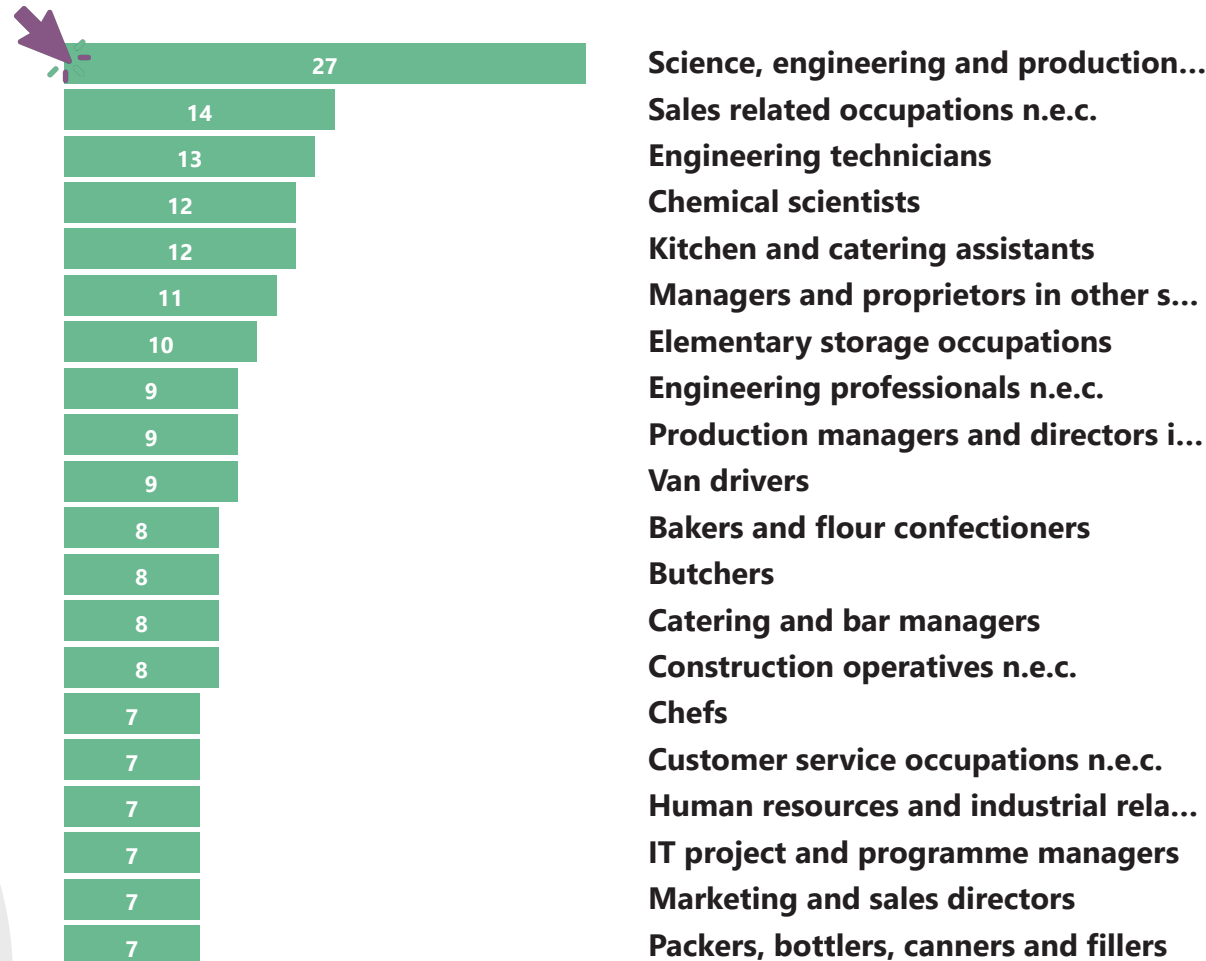

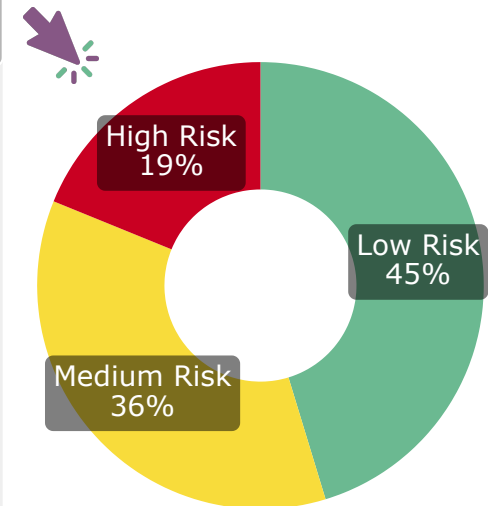

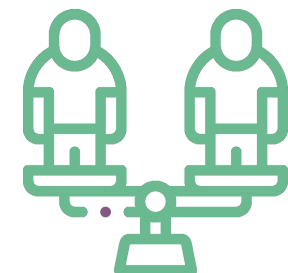

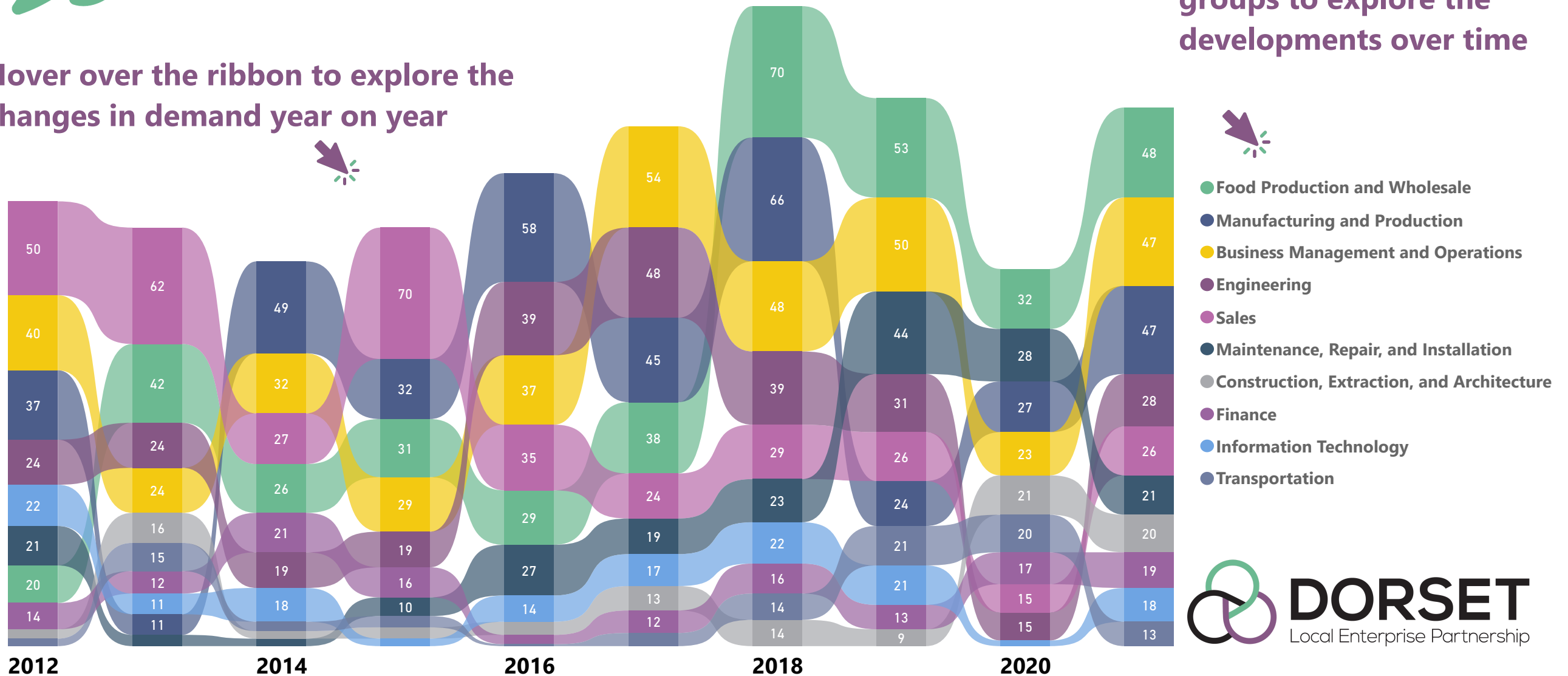
